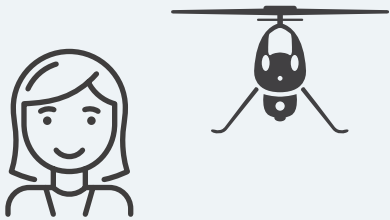




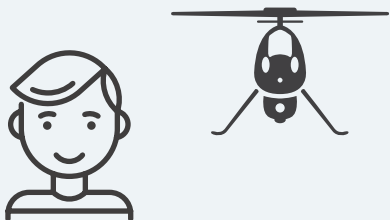
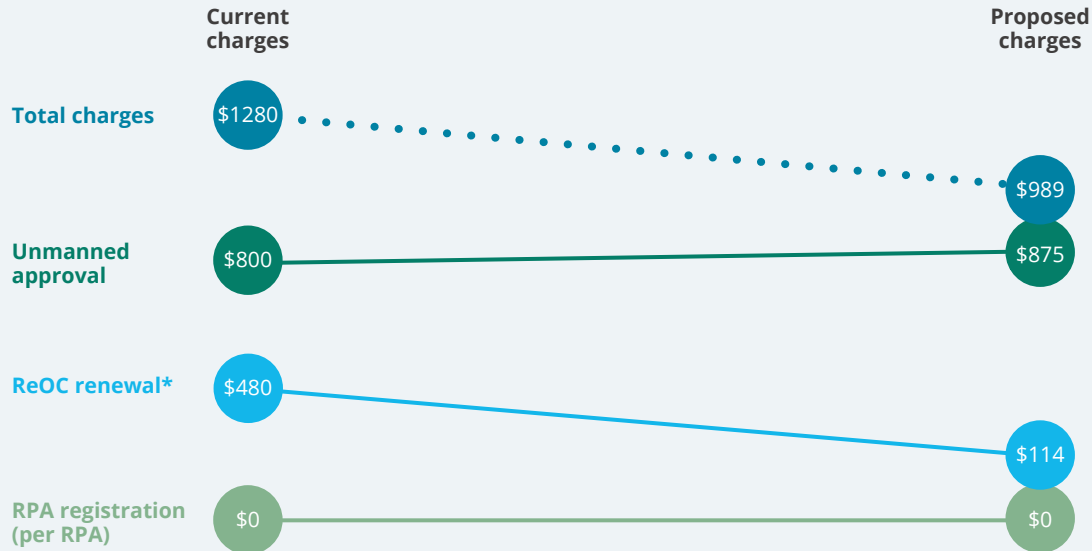
TYPICAL COMMERCIAL AND EXCLUDED RPA OPERATOR SCENARIOS

CASA has analysed client data to demonstrate the effect of the proposed remotely piloted aircraft (RPA) registration levy and change in regulatory fees for typical commercial and excluded RPA operators. This illustration compares current charges with the proposed charges for actual client operations. They have been deidentified for publication.



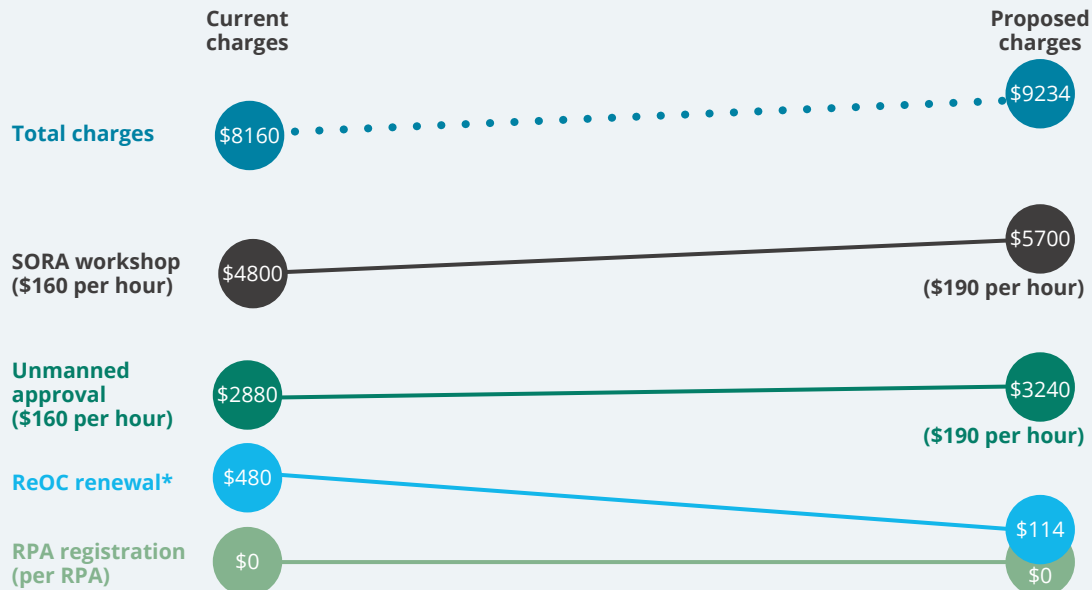
SCENARIO

An existing commercial operator is due to renew their ReOC and obtain a new unmanned aircraft approval to operate a drone within 3 nautical miles of a controlled aerodrome. From 30 September 2020, they will also be required to register their RPA.



SCENARIO

An existing commercial operator is due to renew their ReOC. They also want to apply for an initial unmanned aircraft approval to conduct BVLOS operations. As it's an initial BVLOS approval a SORA (risk assessment) is required, and as it's classified as a complex operation the operator will require a BVLOS instrument. From 30 September 2020, they will also be required to register their RPA.



* ReOC renewal is due every three years.



SCENARIO

An existing commercial operator wants to apply for a single category (not RePL training) variation to the privileges of their ReOC for RPAS aerial work. From 30 September 2020, they will also be required to register their RPA.

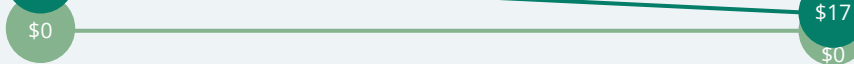
