- 5.2 A Chief Pilot must, unless CASA approves otherwise in writing, meet the requirements set out in Table 5.2, Chief Pilot Requirements.
- 5.3 In Table 5.2, for the type and number of balloons mentioned in the same row of columns 1 and 2, the Chief Pilot must meet the minimum total flight time requirements, the balloon transport experience requirements and the other requirements mentioned in columns 3, 4 and 5, respectively, of the same row.
