**CASA EX64/22 — Flight Training and Flight Tests by Grade 1 Training Endorsement Holders (Exemptions and Approvals) Instrument 2022**

**1 Name**

This instrument is *CASA EX64/22 — Flight Training and Flight Tests by Grade 1 Training Endorsement Holders (Exemptions and Approvals) Instrument 2022*.

**2 Duration**

This instrument:

- (a) commences on 1 September 2022; and
- (b) is repealed at the end of 31 August 2025.

**3 Interpretation**

- (1) In this instrument, unless the contrary intention appears:

***Flight examiner rating course*** means the course of that name, prepared by CASA, as existing from time to time.

***Part 141 operator*** has the meaning given by subregulation 141.015 (3) of CASR.

***table 61.1235*** means the table in regulation 61.1235 of CASR.

- (2) In this instrument, a term mentioned in column 1 of the following table has the same meaning as in the provision of Part 61 of CASR mentioned in column 2 for the term:

#### **4 Flight training — exemptions**

- (1) A flight instructor who holds a grade 1 training endorsement is exempt from compliance with subregulation 61.065 (1) of CASR to the extent that the provision (when taken together with regulation 61.1165 and subregulation 61.1175 (1)) prevents the flight instructor from conducting flight training of a kind mentioned in column 1 of Table 1 in relation to the holder of a pilot licence.
- (2) The following exemptions apply in support of subsection (1):
  - (a) a Part 141 operator who employs a flight instructor exempted under subsection (1) is exempt from compliance with regulation 141.175 of CASR to the extent that the flight instructor, in conducting the flight training mentioned, is not authorised under Part 61 to do so;
  - (b) the head of operations of the Part 141 operator is exempt from compliance with subparagraph 141.130 (4) (b) (i) of CASR to the extent that the flight instructor, in conducting the flight training mentioned, is not authorised under Part 61 to do so;

- (c) a Part 142 operator who employs a flight instructor exempted under subsection (1) is exempt from compliance with regulation 142.230 of CASR to the extent that the flight instructor, in conducting the flight training mentioned, is not authorised under Part 61 to do so;
- (d) the head of operations of the Part 142 operator is exempt from compliance with subparagraph 142.190 (2) (n) (i) of CASR to the extent that the flight instructor, in conducting the flight training mentioned, is not authorised under Part 61 to do so.

*Note* The exemption under subsection (1) does not constitute an authorisation under Part 61 of CASR and, as a consequence, the exemptions under subsection (2) are required.

- (3) The exemption of a person under subsection (1) or (2) in relation to flight training of a kind mentioned in column 1 of Table 1 is subject to the conditions mentioned in column 2 of the table for the flight training.

*Note* For the avoidance of doubt, the exemptions in this section are not conditional on the flight instructor holding an instructor rating training endorsement under item 14 of table 61.1235.

## **5 Flight testing and granting ratings and endorsements — approvals**

- (1) This section applies in relation to a flight instructor:
  - (a) who holds a grade 1 training endorsement; and
  - (b) who, within the previous 24 months, has completed an instructor proficiency check.
- (2) The flight instructor is approved under regulation 61.040 of CASR, for the purposes of subregulation 61.245 (3), to conduct a flight test for the grant of an authorisation mentioned in column 1 of Table 2 in relation to the holder of a pilot licence.
- (3) The flight instructor is approved under regulation 61.040 of CASR, for the purposes of subregulation 61.150 (7), to grant an authorisation mentioned in column 1 of Table 2 in relation to the holder of a pilot licence.
- (4) An approval under this section in relation to a flight test for the grant of an authorisation, and the grant of an authorisation, mentioned in column 1 of Table 2 is subject to the following conditions:
  - (a) the flight instructor must hold the endorsements or rating (as the case may be) mentioned in column 2 of Table 2 for the authorisation;
  - (b) the flight instructor must be conducting the flight test, or granting the authorisation, for or on behalf of a Part 141 operator who is authorised to conduct the flight training concerned, and has assessed the flight instructor as competent, to conduct a flight test for the grant of an authorisation of that kind;
  - (c) the flight instructor must comply with the following requirements and obligations of Part 61 of CASR in respect of the flight test as if the instructor were a flight examiner:
    - (i) subregulations 61.1275 (2) and (3);
    - (ii) paragraphs 61.1280 (2) (e) and (3) (d);
    - (iii) regulation 61.1295;
    - (iv) subregulations 61.1300 (4) and (5);
  - (d) the flight instructor must not:
    - (i) assess a person's competency for the grant of the authorisation; or
    - (ii) complete administrative matters associated with that grant,unless the flight instructor has obtained the prior approval of CASA to do so, following the successful completion by the flight instructor of such e-learning modules of the Flight examiner rating course as CASA considers appropriate.
